Find The Numbers

Pairing Objects

In Reception/MP2 class we had an activity of pairing objects of the same type. For this activity we used classroom objects. After presenting the object, the teacher gave children the object to examine it and one child would tell the teacher were it belongs. This way we learned classroom objects vocabulary and sorting objects of the same kind at the same time.

SENSES!

We focused on Interactive reading as it is one of the best activities to boost our vocabulary and have fun at the same time.














My Favorite Toy

In Language activity, we learnt the letter Tt. We formed the letter T using play to build our fine motor skills. We formed the letter T also by using crepe paper, we crumbled up small peices of paper and we glued them together to form the letter T, this activity improving our fine motor skills. 
