
Practicing additions by using legos and a hand model.


















The children started to match different objects according to the numbers and played different games using shapes that we have learned: triangle, circle, square and rectangle.



We learnt about the importance of the Sun in the lives of living things (as a source of heat, light and energy)

































We visited Science Fair held in our school.

We learn Turkish through various games and activities.

































We learnt how to express our feelings in a positive way.








We learnt about everyjob has a different role in social life by a puppet show.
















The children worked in teams to make the 3D plan of the classroom using the woden toys available. And they draw the map of our classroom
